



Report: Awareness Drive by NCC Wing, ABVGIET

The NCC Wing of ABVGIET conducted an awareness drive addressing the rising issue of drug abuse on 21.11.2025, for youths wrongly perceive as a means to cope with stress or achieve mental prosperity. Cadets highlighted how drug abuse harms health, weakens discipline, and disrupts personal and academic growth.
