



Eligibility Criteria for Selection of Cadets for ATC and Other NCC Camps

To ensure a fair, transparent, and merit-based selection of cadets for participation in National Cadet Corps camps such as Army Attachment Camp (ATT) and other centrally/locally organized camps, an eligibility and selection criteria shall be followed. The purpose of these criteria is to ensure that sincere, disciplined, and deserving cadets get fair opportunity to represent the institution in National Cadet Corps camps while promoting merit, discipline, and equal exposure among cadets.

Selection of cadets for camps shall be based on the following parameters:

1. **Attendance in NCC Theory Classes, Drill Practice / Parades:** Regular attendance in scheduled NCC theory & drill classes shall be a primary criterion. Cadets with higher attendance percentage shall be given preference.
2. **Performance in BEE Certificate Examination:** Cadets securing higher marks/grades in the *BEE Certificate Examination* shall be accorded priority during camp nominations.
3. **Discipline and Obedience:** Discipline, punctuality, obedience to orders, turnout, and overall conduct shall play a major role in selection. Any act of indiscipline or violation of NCC/institutional rules may render a cadet ineligible.
4. **Drill Performance and Marching Skills:** Cadets demonstrating good drill standards, marching discipline, synchronization, command response, and overall parade performance shall have an edge over others in selection.
5. **Camp Rotation / Opportunity to All Cadets:** To provide fair opportunity to all deserving cadets, a cadet who has attended one camp shall normally be given **least priority** for selection to the very next camp, unless exceptional merit or camp-specific requirements justify otherwise.
