National Cadet Corps (NCC) Guidelines Document

1. Introduction

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a premier youth organization that instils discipline, leadership, patriotism, and a spirit of service among students. It provides opportunities for cadets to develop their personality, physical fitness, and leadership skills through structured training and camps.

2. Importance of NCC

- Develops leadership qualities, discipline and teamwork.
- Promotes a spirit of adventure through various outdoor activities.
- Enhances physical fitness and mental toughness.
- Provides opportunities for national integration and social service.
- Opens career prospects in the armed forces and other government sectors.
- Encourages discipline and responsibility towards the nation.

3. Motto of NCC

"Unity and Discipline"

This motto emphasizes the importance of national unity and self-discipline in shaping responsible citizens.

4. Discipline Guidelines for NCC Cadets

To maintain the integrity and reputation of NCC, all cadets must adhere to the following discipline guidelines:

1. **Punctuality:** Cadets must report on time for all NCC parades, training sessions, and events.
2. **Uniform & Grooming:** Cadets must wear their NCC uniform properly and maintain personal hygiene at all times.
3. **Respect & Conduct:** Respect must be shown to officers, instructors, and fellow cadets. Any form of misbehaviour, including disrespectful language or actions, will not be tolerated.
4. **Attendance:** Regular attendance is mandatory. Absence without prior permission may lead to disciplinary action. 75% attendance is mandatory for appearing in BEE and CEE certificate Examination.
5. **Prohibition of Unethical Behaviour:** Cadets must refrain from smoking, drinking, using drugs, or engaging in any form of misconduct that tarnishes the image of NCC.

6. **No Political or Religious Affiliation:** NCC activities should not be influenced by political or religious ideologies.
7. **Proper Communication:** Any grievances or issues should be addressed to the NCC coordinator through the proper chain of command.
8. **Use of Social Media:** Cadets must refrain from posting anything inappropriate related to NCC on social media. Any violation will be strictly dealt with.
9. **Team Spirit:** Cadets must work together and support each other, avoiding conflicts and promoting camaraderie.
10. **Handling Equipment & Property:** NCC equipment, weapons, and training material must be handled with care. Any damage due to negligence will be the responsibility of the cadet.

5. Action Against Defaulters

Any cadet violating the discipline guidelines will face the following consequences:

1. **First Offense:** Verbal warning from the NCC coordinator or senior officers.
2. **Second Offense:** Written warning and deduction of NCC participation marks.
3. **Repeated Violations:** Suspension from NCC activities and possible expulsion from the unit.
4. **Serious Misconduct:** In case of severe indiscipline (fighting, disrespect to officers, illegal activities, etc.), the matter will be escalated to higher authorities, and the cadet may be expelled from NCC and reported to the college administration.

Being an NCC cadet is a privilege and responsibility. It is expected that all cadets will maintain high moral and ethical standards, uphold the dignity of NCC, and serve as role models for others. These guidelines must be followed strictly to ensure a disciplined and efficient NCC unit.
