

Report on the NCC Activities at ABVGIET Pragatinagar Engineering College

Introduction

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Government Institute of Engineering and Technology (ABVGIET) Pragatinagar has played a pivotal role in contributing to various campus activities and events. Major Contributions of NCC

बड़ा भंगाल और दिल्ली में सहायक मतदान केंद्र



लोकसभा चुनाव के लिए अब मुक्ती बच्चे भी हर पोलिंग स्टेशन में अपनी ड्यूटी देंगे। उच्च शिक्षा विभाग ने प्रदेश के हर स्कूल से दो दो ऐसे छात्र, जो एनसीसी के हैं, उनको ड्यूटी पर पोलिंग स्टेशन में लगाने के निर्देश जारी किए हैं। इससे छात्र बॉयस् नारीको, गर्भवती महिलाओं और दिव्यांगों को सुविधा के लिए तैयार होंगे। इनके मतदान केंद्रों पर कैडेट्स बंदी व बिना हॉस्पिटल के तैयार किए जाएंगे, जो यातायात व्यवस्था, भौत निरीक्षण, बूट और दिव्यांगजन मतदाताओं को सहायता, किसी भी प्रकार को आचर निमित्त में निश्चित सहायता जैसे पर मुफ्त संचो

दार्शनिकों में गुलिस कर्मियों व गुरुत्वकों को सहायता करेंगे। चुनाव आयोग का यह कदम युवाओं को लोकतंत्र के सच्चे चहे उल्लेख में शामिल कर उन्हें निर्वाचन प्रक्रिया के प्रति जागरूक करने में सहायक सिद्ध होगा। इनके अन्य मतदान कर्मियों के समान पारिभाषिक दिया जाएगा। उन्होंने कहा कि फैसल केन्द्र को चुनाव ड्यूटी के लिए अन्य मतदान कर्मियों के समान पारिभाषिक दिया जाएगा। इसके अतिरिक्त उन्हें प्रतिदिन 150 रुपए या पेंशन लॉच दिया जाएगा और संबोधित शिक्षा निर्वाचन अधिकारों उनके पारिभाषिक को व्यवस्था करेंगे। किसी भी अव्यवस्थित घटने के मामले में यह कैडेट्स अनुरोध वरिष्ठ के इंतजार होंगे।

सिता। निर्वाचन विभाग के प्रधान ने बतया कि भारत निर्वाचन आयोग ने राज्य निर्वाचन विभाग को कामकाज जितल के 20-बैरनाप (अ.ज.) विभागसमा क्षेत्र के मतदान केंद्र 99-बड़ा भंगाल, जिसमें कुल 469 मतदाता पंजीकृत है और खोलन जितल के 54-कनौली (अ.ज.) के 27-दिल्ली मतदान केंद्र जिसमें 803 मतदाता पंजीकृत है, के लिए सहायक मतदान केंद्र (अतिरिक्तरी खोलन स्टेशन) बनाने की अनुमति प्रदान की है। बागल जितल के 99-बड़ाभंगाल का मतदान केंद्र राजेश्वर प्राथमिक पाठशाला वरुणभंगाल जितल बौड़ में है, जहां अब 30 मतदाता अपने मतपत्रों का प्रयोग करने और कठिन भौतिक परिस्थितियों के दृष्टिकोण से मतदान केंद्र के लिए सहायक मतदान केंद्र, राजकीय उच्च पाठशाला, बड़भंगाल 99-ब-बड़ाभंगाल बनाया गया है, जहां 159 मतदाता मतदान करेंगे। इसके अतिरिक्त, 54-कनौली (अ.ज.) के मतदान केंद्र 27-दिल्ली, जिसका मतदान केंद्र राजकीय प्राथमिक पाठशाला, दिल्ली में स्थित है, जहां अब 800 मतदाता अपने मतपत्रों का प्रयोग करने और कठिन परिस्थितियों की सुविधा के लिए 27-क-दिल्ली के दृष्टिकोण से मतदान केंद्र बनाया गया है और कठिन परिस्थितियों में सहायक मतदान केंद्र स्थित किया गया है, जहां पांच मतदाता मतदान करेंगे। प्रदेश में अब मतदान केंद्रों की संख्या बढ़कर 7992 हो गई है।



Impact and Outcomes

The involvement of the NCC in these major events has led to several positive outcomes:
